

# North Pole Penguin Ornament

Don't ask this penguin the way to the North Pole - he looks a little too confused!

## Materials

- Craft foam: black, white, orange, tan
- Two 5mm wiggle eyes
- 7" plastic candy cane
- 16" length of  $\frac{1}{8}$ " wide red satin ribbon
- Black permanent fine-line marker
- Thick craft glue
- Paper, pencil, scissors, ruler

## Instructions

**1** Trace and cut out patterns. Follow directions on patterns. Cut a  $\frac{3}{4}$ " square from black foam. See photo. Use marker to outline feet and body; write words on each sign as shown.

**2** Make the sign post. Cut away curve from candy cane for a  $6\frac{1}{4}$ " long stick. See photo. Glue signs onto candy cane stick spacing each evenly apart. Let dry.

**3** Assemble the penguin. See photo. Center and glue white body onto black body. Glue wings to each side of body. Glue feet to back of body so  $\frac{3}{4}$ " of feet extend beyond bottom of body. Glue eyes side-by-side to face and beaks below eyes as shown.

**4** Finish up. See photo. Glue sign post to penguin. For bow, cut a 6" length from ribbon. Tie ribbon into a 1" wide bow; cut ribbon ends at a slant. Glue bow to white body as shown. For hanging loop, tie ends of remaining length of ribbon in a knot. Glue knot to back of head. Glue  $\frac{3}{4}$ " black foam square over hanging loop just above knot. ★
