

PATROL CHALLENGE #1

1. Only Scouts wearing neck-a-chiefs may speak.
 2. Have your Patrol stand in a circle.
 3. Have your Patrol interlock arms.
4. Have each member stand on his left foot, only.
5. Rotate the circle 90 degrees right, then back 180 degrees left.

PATROL CHALLENGE #3

1. The entire Patrol may speak, but only while pinching their noses closed.
2. Place your Patrol in a circle, sitting on the floor.
3. Have your Patrol come up with a positive poem about the Senior Patrol Leader.
4. Have your Patrol find the Senior Patrol Leader and give him a proper Scout salute.
5. Have your entire Patrol recite your poem to the Senior Patrol Leader.

PATROL CHALLENGE #5

1. Only your Patrol Leader may speak.
2. Get the American and Troop flags.
 3. Pick a color guard of 4 Scouts.
4. Put on a flag presentation for your Patrol.
5. Put the flags back where you found them.

PATROL CHALLENGE #7

1. All Scouts may speak, but, only when standing on one foot.
 2. Have your Patrol spread out.
3. Have each Patrol member stand on his tip toes.
4. Have each Patrol member place one hand on his head and his other hand in his pocket.
5. Remaining in this position, have your Patrol members pair off and place their backs together.

PATROL CHALLENGE #9

1. Only Scouts over 5 foot tall, but under 6 foot tall, may speak.
2. Line up your Patrol facing the South wall of the room.
3. Have your Patrol members tie their shoe laces to the shoes of the Scouts on either side of them.
4. Have your Patrol members put both the hands on top of their heads.
5. Have your Patrol move to each wall in the room, while in this formation.

PATROL CHALLENGE #2

1. Only Scouts weighing less than 100 pounds may speak.
2. Line up your Patrol, single file, facing true North.
 3. Have all Patrol members grab their ankles.
4. Remaining in that position, have the Patrol sit down.
5. Still holding their ankles, have the Patrol stand up and take 5 paces backwards.

PATROL CHALLENGE #4

1. Pick your Patrol member with the largest nose – Only he may speak.
 2. Have your Patrol remove their shoes.
3. Give all your shoes to your Patrol's youngest member.
4. Have your Patrol face the wall, while your youngest Patrol member hides the shoes.
5. Have your Patrol find their shoes and put them on.

PATROL CHALLENGE #6

1. Only Scouts wearing their Scout hats may speak.
2. Line your Patrol up facing the east wall of the room.
3. Have your Patrol spread out, finger tip to finger tip.
 4. Have the Patrol do 10 jumping jacks. Each Scout must do each jumping jack at the same time.
5. Have the Patrol do 25-toe touches. Each Scout must do each toe touch at the same time.

PATROL CHALLENGE #8

1. Only Scouts wearing glasses may speak.
2. Have your Patrol Quartermaster obtain rope from the Scoutmaster – one piece per Patrol member.
 3. Pair off your Patrol members.
4. Have each Scout tie the rope around himself using a bowline. Then have the pairs tie their ropes together using a square knot.
5. Have each pair of Scouts lean back until their ropes are tight and remain in that positions for 1 minute.

PATROL CHALLENGE #10

1. All Scouts may speak, but only with a German accent.
 2. Place your Patrol in a circle.
3. Have your Patrol members hold the hands of the Scout across from them.
 4. Start rotating the circle clockwise.
5. Maintaining your rotation, move your circle to all corners of the room.

PATROL CHALLENGE #11

1. All Scouts may speak.
2. Have the patrol form a single file and sit down.
3. Have the first Scout in line give the first Scout Law, stand and run to the back of the line, then sit down.
4. Have the second Scout, now at the front of the line, give the second point of the Scout Law, run to the back and sit down.
5. Continue the process until all of the Scout Laws have been given, in order. Remember you must wait until the last Scout has sat down before giving the next law.

PATROL CHALLENGE #13

1. Only the Assistant Patrol Leader may speak.
 2. Divide your Patrol in half.
3. Have the Patrol form two lines, facing each other.
4. Have the Scouts put their thumbs in their ears and stick out their tongues.
5. Have your Patrol remain in this position for one minute, without laughing. If anyone laughs, your time starts over.

PATROL CHALLENGE #15

1. Only Scouts having their Scout Handbooks may speak.
 2. Place your Patrol in a circle, standing up.
3. Have all of the Scouts place their toes together.
4. Have all of the Scouts take the hands of the Scout across from them.
5. Have all of the Scouts lean back and hold that position for one minute.

PATROL CHALLENGE #17

1. All Scouts may speak, in a whisper.
2. Sit your Patrol at a table, by age, youngest Scout on the end.
 3. Ask the Scoutmaster for a pencil and paper.
 4. Write down the seven food groups.
5. Write down a menu for a breakfast, lunch and dinner, with each containing all seven-food groups. Present it to the Scoutmaster or one of his Assistants.

PATROL CHALLENGE #19

1. All Scouts may speak.
 2. Blindfold the entire Patrol.
 3. Sit the patrol in a circle, on the floor.
4. Have the Patrol listen for 3 quick claps from the judge, ignoring any other combination of claps.
5. The 3 quick claps are a fire alarm. When you hear it, using proper techniques, get your Patrol to the parking lot, as quickly as possible.

PATROL CHALLENGE #12

1. All Scouts may speak, but only in questions.
2. Line up your Patrol alphabetically, by middle names.
3. Have each Scout put their right hand on the left shoulder of the Scout in front of them and their left hand on the right shoulder of that Scout.
 4. Have the Scouts cross their feet.
5. Staying in this position, have the Patrol sit down.

PATROL CHALLENGE #14

1. All Scouts may speak.
2. Form the Patrol in a circle, starting with the tallest Scout and going, by height, counter clockwise.
3. Have all of the Scouts clap their hands quietly.
4. Starting with the tallest Scout and going clockwise, recite the Scout Law, over and over, backwards.
5. Continue for two minutes. Your time starts over every time you get out of order.

PATROL CHALLENGE #16

1. Only Scouts in full Scout uniform may speak.
2. Get a long piece of rope from the Scoutmaster.
3. Place your Patrol in a single file, tying all of the Scouts' right angles together with the rope.
4. Walk the Patrol around the room until you find a Scout Fieldbook.
5. Take the Scout Fieldbook to the Scoutmaster.

PATROL CHALLENGE #18

1. Only Scouts with a perfect attendance record during the previous month may speak.
2. Have your Patrol give all their Handbooks to the Patrol Leader.
 3. Have your Patrol put their heads down.
4. Have your Patrol Leader hide the Handbooks, all in one place, then draw a simple map to show where they are.
 5. Have the Patrol find their Handbooks.

PATROL CHALLENGE #20

1. Only Scouts wearing black shoes may speak.
 2. Pair off your Patrol members.
 3. Have each pair sit down, back to back.
4. Not using their hands, have each pair stand up.
5. Maintaining back to back contact, have your Patrol walk completely around the edges of the room. Scouts losing contact will cause the Patrol to have to start over.
