

Scout Promise "Hate Mail"

Idea from: 4th Tyldesly Scout Troop

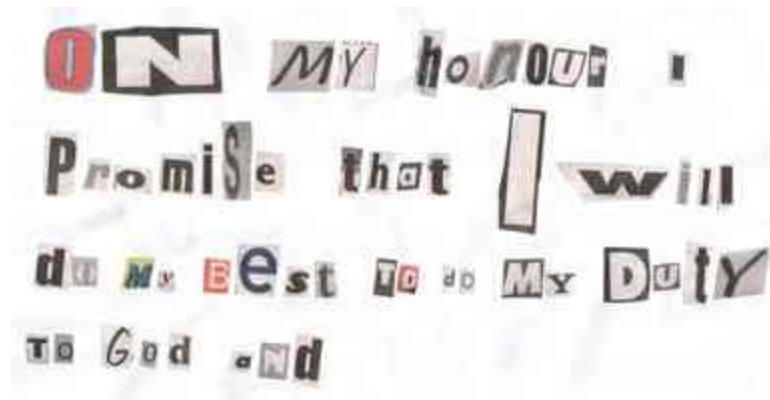
Requirements:

1. Old news papers
2. Glue
3. Scissors
4. Paper

Instructions:

- This activity is **very** simple but will keep the Scouts busy for ages. The idea is to make a 'hate mail' style letter of the Scout Promise. The letters of each word are cut out from the old newspapers and stuck onto the paper.
- This activity will take much longer than you think - to complete the Scout Promise it will take about 2 hours. If you can not or do not want to carry the activity into the next troop meeting you could change the subject of the letter. One example would be to split the Scout laws between all the Patrols, or maybe get them to do a joke which can be pinned up in the Scout hut.
- **Note.** From experience I would recommend using a stick glue such as "Prit Stick". I used glue pens and by the end of the activity some of the papers were swimming in glue!
